

Policy for students with disabilities

1. The disability policy is committed to the principles of equity, access, opportunity and rights. It seeks to apply these principles to all aspects of admission & learning process.
2. The Institute will take all reasonable steps to ensure that courses (including placements, field trips, study abroad and other specialist learning environments) are organized to offer the best possible opportunities for full participation by all students including "Persons with Disabilities.
3. The institute shall aim to ensure that Students and staff with disabilities, have equal access to all student and academic services. While it is recognized that some of these services are located in buildings which have access problems, the institute will ensure that the service can be provided in such a way that the needs of the students with disabilities are met. Examples of this would be assistance in libraries to obtain books, provision of information in large print, access ramps to the buildings and other important academic/recreational areas, dedicated washroom, dedicated parking area.
4. This policy ensures the provision of on campus residential facilities to students with disabilities. Subject to availability, students with disabilities will be offered equal access to institute accommodation.

Individuals with disabilities on the basis of disability and/or any other status or characteristic as defined and to the extent protected by applicable law.
