

Policy against Violence inside campus.

Violence Definition:

1. The exercise of physical force by a person against any person in the campus or outside campus which could cause physical injury;
2. an attempt to exercise physical force against any person
3. A statement or behavior that it is reasonable for a person to interpret as a threat to exercise physical force against them.

Policy:

Campus violence and harassment will not be tolerated at BVCOE campus. BVCOE will take all reasonable steps to protect students from campus violence and harassment and will investigate and deal with all incidents and complaints in a fair and timely manner, respecting the privacy of all concerned as much as possible. Individuals who commit campus violence and harassment may be subject to disciplinary action, criminal penalties, or both. Retaliation or reprisals are prohibited against any person who, in good faith, has complained under this policy.

Disciplinary Action In case of violation of above rules following disciplinary action is proposed:

- i. Referring the case to disciplinary action committee.
- ii. Removal from college
