1. Students are required to make a project in a group of 3 members.
2. Students should approach the faculty members to request for their Mentorship during the Mini project tenure. The research areas of faculties of CSE have been attached for reference.
3. Students are required to submit the details of their groups, mentor details and the topic of their research work (duly signed by mentor) to their class advisors latest by 25th August 2025
4. Project Synopsis should be submitted as per the prescribed format, to respective class advisors (duly signed by the mentor).

The synopsis should be printed on A4 size paper and can have 10-15 pages. The content of synopsis must include:

- Title Page
- Introduction
- Problem Statement
- Literature Review
- Objectives
- Proposed Methodology
- References (in IEEE format only)




Note:

- The project must include design problems or steps. Comparative analysis of an existing work will not be accepted as a project.
- Interdisciplinary research projects are encouraged.
- The Project Evaluation will be based on the emerging trends, novelty, innovation and real time problems.
- **It is mandatory for all students to publish a research paper in international conference (SCOPUS Indexed) or reputed journal. Evaluation of Mini Project will be part of the “Lab Innovation” criteria (32 marks) of the continuous assessment of all Lab subjects.**


