Rules and Regulations for Students

- All students must wear identity card while entering and inside the campus. Student should carry his/ her identity card and produce it on demand by the authorities.
- 2. Smoking, consumption or possession of toxic/alcoholic drinks or drugs within the campus is strictly prohibited.
- 3. All students must follow formal dress code within the campus.
- 4. Do not litter inside the campus. Keep campus neat and clean.
- Any scribing/writing on the desks, drawing tables/boards or walls should be totally avoided.
- Unauthorized screening of any film, videos or camera anywhere inside the campus is totally forbidden.
- 7. Students are not allowed to use mobile phone inside classrooms, laboratories and library.
- 8. Students are advised to follow proper code of conduct to resolve all issues and queries.
- Students are advised to attend classes and laboratories regularly as per time table. 75% attendance is mandatory to appear in final examination.
- Behaviour of students within or outside college premises should be decent and befitting to a professional institute.
- All students should follow rules and regulations conveyed by anti-ragging committee of the institute.
- 12. Students are not allowed to enter/park four wheeler inside the campus. Only two wheeler entry/parking is allowed.
- 13. Library facility can be availed by all students from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm during all week days.
- 14. All students residing outside the campus can avail mess facility as per institute rules and regulations.
- 15. Students shall keep themselves informed of the instructions issued to them from time to time orally or through notices/ circulars and emails.
- Participation in intercollegiate programmes, within the city or outside, is subject to permission of the Principal.
- 17. For outstation programmes including study tour, the students are required to submit a permission letter from their parents.
- 18. Students are prohibited from organizing or attending meetings in the college, distributing notices, collecting money and exhibiting banners, flags, posters etc. without the permission of the Principal.
- 19. All expressions or activities which are immoral, antisocial, communal and anti-national are strictly prohibited in the College campus.
- 20. The Principal shall be the final authority in the interpretation of the College rules. Matters not covered by these rules are left to the discretion of the Principal and his decision shall be final.
