

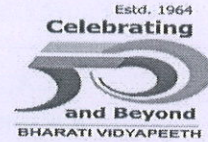


1. **Title of the Event:** StepNext (A Pre-placement Bootcamp)
