## Student's Guidelines

1. Students must wear College ID Card within college premises. Students have to show their college ID cards whenever asked by college authority.
2. Students must wear formal attire within the college premises.
3. Students are not allowed to use mobile phone inside classrooms, laboratories and library.
4. Students are advised to attend classes and laboratories regularly as per time table. A minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory to be eligible for the final examination.
5. Students are strictly advised against organizing or participating in mass absences (bunking) from classes.
6. Students must avoid inappropriate or abusive language within the college premises. Violations will result in a Rs. 1,000 fine.
7. Students should maintain decent behaviour both inside and outside the college, reflecting the standards of a professional institute.
8. Students are advised to avoid sitting on staircases to ensure clear passage.
9. Students are strictly prohibited from organizing any unauthorized events in the name of the college
10. Students are strictly prohibited from consuming or bringing tobacco products, e-cigarettes, cigarettes, alcohol, or any similar substances within the college campus.
11. Students involved in any altercation or physical confrontation within the college will face immediate suspension and a fine of Rs. 1,000.
12. Students involved in theft of personal belongings or damage to property will be required to compensate for the loss, and an additional fine of Rs. 10,000 will be imposed.
13. Students must follow the rules and regulations set by the institute's anti-ragging committee.
14. Students are not allowed to bring or park four-wheelers inside the campus. Only two wheeler entry/parking is allowed.
15. Students are advised to avoid littering and must maintain cleanliness to keep the campus neat.
16. Students are strictly prohibited for unauthorized screening of any film, video, or camera recording inside campus.
17. Students can use the library from 8:30 AM to 9:00 PM except holidays listed in academic calendar.
18. Students residing outside the campus can avail mess facility as per institute rules and regulations.
19. Students must stay updated on instructions given from time to time through announcements, notices, circulars, or emails.
20. Students must obtain the Principal's permission to participate in intercollege programs, whether within the city or outside.
21. Students must submit a permission letter from their parents for outstation programs, including study tours.
22. Students are not allowed to organize or attend meetings, distribute notices, collect money, or display banners and flags in the college without the Principal's permission.
23. Students are strictly prohibited from engaging in any immoral, antisocial, communal, or anti-national expressions or activities within the college premises.
24. Principal has the final authority in interpreting college rules. Any matters not covered by these rules will be decided at the Principal's discretion, and the decision will be final.
