INTERNSHIP POLICY

The technical internship is a crucial part of the B.Tech curriculum that offers students the opportunity to gain hands-on experience in a professional work setting. The internship provides an opportunity for students to gain practical experience and exposure to technical and managerial aspects of organizations, as well as to enhance their communication and networking skills. The technical internship program is an important component of the academic curriculum for B.Tech students. The objectives of the internship program include the application of analytical, integrative, and team skills in the workplace, as well as networking with industry professionals.

Internship Policies

1. The duration of the internship(s) may vary, but typically, summer internships last between six and eight weeks, and specific courses may require two or more summer internships.
2. The internship is mandatory for all students after the 2nd year, 3rd year, and 4th year, and they must complete the minimum duration specified in the curriculum (six to eight weeks during the summer break after their end-of-term exams in the 2nd and 3rd years, and six months in the 4th year).
3. After the 2nd year, students are allowed to undergo summer in-house training, and after the 3rd year, students must undertake industrial training. Successful completion of these is mandatory for the award of the degree by the University.
4. The Training and Placement Department is responsible for organizing the summer in-house training and providing training to students in the latest technological skills required by the industry. Trained faculty members and external agencies provide training to students.
5. The Training and Placement Department and respective departments also facilitate the internship process for industrial training. The Training and Placement Department assists in organizing internship opportunities for students. Students are also encouraged to search for internships aligned with their specific career interests with the support of the departments.

Internships offer several benefits to students, including:


1. **Practical Experience:** An internship offers students an opportunity to gain practical experience in a professional setting. They can learn about the company's operations, culture, and industry, which can be invaluable in preparing for their future careers.
